

INFORMATION CLAUSE (ARTICLE 13) - for conference /special meeting/event participant:

Pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (OJ. EU L 119 of 04.05.2016, p. 1, as amended), hereinafter referred to as "GDPR", I would like to inform you that:

Information concerning personal data processed

Your personal data shall be processed pursuant to Article 6 (1) (a):

- 1) first and last name, signature - in order to organise and hold a conference/special meeting (event);
- 2) image – for the purpose of general recording of the course of the event (photographs and videos) and promoting events on the website of the Office, in the "Bezpieczeństwo Pracy i Ochrona Środowiska w Górnictwie" [Labour Safety and Environmental Protection in Mining] monthly, and in special publications published in paper and electronic form.

Recipients of personal data

The recipients of your personal data will be employees authorised to process personal data, and personal data may be made available to entities authorised to do so on the basis of applicable laws and entities providing services for our benefit requiring access to personal data.

Your personal data shall not be transferred to third countries or international organisations.

Data processing period

Your personal data will be stored for no longer than until the consent is withdrawn or objections to the processing are raised. You may withdraw your consent to the processing of personal data, e.g. by sending an e-mail to iod@wug.gov.pl.

Rights of the data subject

You have the right to:

- 1) access the contents of your data, the right to rectify, erase or limit processing thereof;
- 2) transfer data, object, withdraw consent at any time – withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing performed on the basis of consent before its withdrawal;
- 3) lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office, ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warszawa, Poland, if you consider that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of GDPR.

The provision of your personal data is necessary for participation in the conference/special meeting/event.

Your data shall not be processed by automated means, including profiling.
